

Dr. Griesbach received her doctorate in Behavioral Neuroscience at the University of Texas at Austin and later joined as faculty at the Department of Neurosurgery at the University of CA, Los Angeles. Dr. Griesbach is most well known for her NIH funded research on traumatic brain injury that has focused on mechanisms that facilitate recovery and enhance rehabilitation. She is a reviewer for the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke, Veterans Administration and is a member of the Federal Advisory Committee for the Scientific Merit Review Board for Brain Injury. She is also a member of the NIH and Department of Defense (DOD) Sports Concussion Common Data Elements Working Group. She currently holds a position at the Neurosurgery Department at University of CA, Los Angeles and is the National Director of Clinical Research at the Centre for Neuro Skills.
