Dr. Kolakowsky-Hayner is the Chief Operating Officer at the Brain Trauma Foundation and also BTF's Principal Investigator on the Brain Trauma Evidence-based Consortium project funded by the U.S. Army Research, Development and Engineering Command and the Site-PI for the Eye Tracking Rapid Attention Computation Advance study funded by the Office of Naval Research. Dr. Kolakowsky-Hayner serves as the Immediate Past Chairman of the Board of the Brain Injury Association of California. She is a member of the Academy of Certified Brain Injury Specialists' Board of Governors and the American Congress of Rehabilitation Medicine Board of Governors. Stephanie is the Vocational-Community Issues Panel Chair for the Brain Injury Association of America and Mount Sinai's Guidelines for Rehabilitation and Chronic Disease Management of Adults with Moderate to Severe Traumatic Brain Injury development project. She also serves on the Community Advisory Board of the DOD-funded Chronic Effects of Neurotrauma Consortium and as the Co-Chair of the 4th Federal Interagency Conference on Traumatic Brain Injury.
